- To familiarize students with modern approaches to studying contentions politics, social movements and their dynamics (including polarization, escalation and radicalization);
- To develop abilities for critical analysis of socio-political and ideological conflicts in modern world, their causes and developments;
- To develop skills for mediation in socio-political sphere.
