

Sociological research of social structures, organizations and management-2.

The discipline is aimed at students mastering the basic theoretical and empirical areas of sociological study of organizations, management and labor relations, mastering the skills of assessing the motivational background of the organization's staff, the level of conflict in the team; identifying the level of cohesion of the organization, as well as informal groups, leaders and outsiders, mastering sociological methods of analysis of interpersonal relationships in the team (sociometric method, construction of sociomatrix and sociogram, survey method).

The task of the discipline is the formation of skills:

- identification of the most effective management styles in different types of organizations;
- assessment of the motivational background of the organization's staff, the level of conflict in the team;
- identifying the level of cohesion of the organization's staff, as well as informal groups, leaders and outsiders;
- possession of technology for the development and implementation of management decisions;
- application of sociological methods of analysis of interpersonal relations in the team (sociometric method, construction of sociomatrix and sociogram, survey method);
- identifying the level of leadership qualities of leaders, leadership styles.
