

Sociology of youth and family

The purpose of the educational component is to acquire knowledge about the role of youth and family in modern society.

The discipline belongs to the cycle of professional training. Discipline "Sociology of Youth and Family" is related to the disciplines "Sociology personality, education and culture", "General Sociology ", "History of Sociology", given that these disciplines involve the study of special and sectoral sociological theories.

The task of the discipline is the formation of students' ability to analyze youth as a special socio-demographic group, its specifics, ways of socialization, crisis periods of development, problems; understand current research and trends in family development; identify the functions of the family as a social group and institution and general and specific models of family behavior.

Students will use sociological concepts and theories provided by the lecturer to analyze the sociology of youth as a branch of sociological theory, the history of ideas about youth in scientific concepts, the social status of youth in modern society and its dynamics, the theory of generations. Attention will also be paid to group discussions in seminars on youth subcultures, forms of deviant youth behavior, the role of the youth generation in politics, economic activity and business. The sociology of the family will be considered in terms of the types of modern marriages, patterns of family behavior, marital roles and crises in the modern family.
