

## **The second wave of globalization: intrapersonal and interpersonal conflicts - sociological contexts**

### **General description of the discipline, content, relevance**

Each wave of globalization changes is characterized by certain choices of behavioral strategies and tactics, forms of communication and, personality types, respectively. System-wide changes affect the development of the individual - the fundamental actor of social interactions, but no less important is the reverse vector of influence: from the individual, his immediate environment, communities that represent his interests, to the country, the state - the system as a whole. Intrapersonal conflicts become a factor and source of interpersonal, intergroup, and interstate conflicts in general. Therefore, the main purpose of the course is to provide students with professional knowledge and skills to study trends in social change and modernization / DE modernization of Ukrainian society in the context of global dynamics

#### **The purpose of the discipline is to form students' abilities:**

- to abstract thinking, analysis and synthesis;
- to search, process and analyze information from various sources make informed decisions;
- ability to apply the acquired knowledge in practical situations;
- ability to analyze social changes taking place in Ukraine and the world as a whole

**Importance for the practical using:** Use the dialectical contradictions of globalization and localization, universal and national values, to improve their competencies, skills and abilities as a patriot of civil society and a responsible supporter of stable noospheric development. Not to transfer unresolved internal conflicts to the processes of interaction, but on the contrary, to grow, to acquire autonomy and subjectivity in industrial communications and leisure - this is how students can use the knowledge and skills acquired during the study of this course.
